

mop cover



I don't want to infringe on any trademarks so I will give you a photo, outline and shape of the mop and you can probably figure which mop I used. I was tired of buying those expensive little detergent filed pads that really didn't do much if I needed to scrub. This cover is knit entirely of Sugar and Cream on size 6 needles. You can get 2 out of one ball of yarn or use up all your scraps.

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k knit
p purl
k2tog knit 2 together
Inc increase by knitting in front and back of stitch

Cast On 2 stitches

Bind off

(RS) Starting at one end pick up 40 stitches along one side.
 Pick up 20 stitches along side to marker.
 Pick up 20 stitches along side to end.
 Pick up 20 stitches along other side to marker.
 Pick up 20 stitches along other side to beginning.
 Join.
 Knit 3 rows in the round.
 BO 4 stitches.
 Put 5 stitches on stitch holder.
 BO 26 stitches
 Put 5 stitches on stitch holder
 BO remaining 42 stitches.
 Put first 5 stitches on needle. Knit 10 rows bind off.
 Sew bound of end of 5 stitches to other side of pad.
 Repeat for other 5 stitches on stitch holder.
 Stretch it on your mop and mop on!
