

## Peacock's Tail Pattern

Cast on any number of stitches divisible 9 plus 4 edge stitches.

Design is worked over 6 rows.

Row 1	*k2, [yo, k1]. 5 times. yo, k2*. Repeat **
Row 2	*p2, k11, p2*. Repeat **
Row 3	*k2tog, k11, k2togtbl*. Repeat **.
Row 4	*p2tog, p9, p2togtbl*. Repeat **
Row 5	*k2tog, k7, k2togtbl*. Repeat **.
Row 6	p

### NOTES:

There are 2 edge stitches at the beginning and end of each row. These stitches are worked in stockinette stitch and not included in the written pattern or chart.

Instead of purl 2 together through the back loop, you may purl 1, slip purled stitch back on left needle, pass the next stitch over the purled stitch and slip the purled stitch back onto the right needle.
